• **Ask an adult for help**

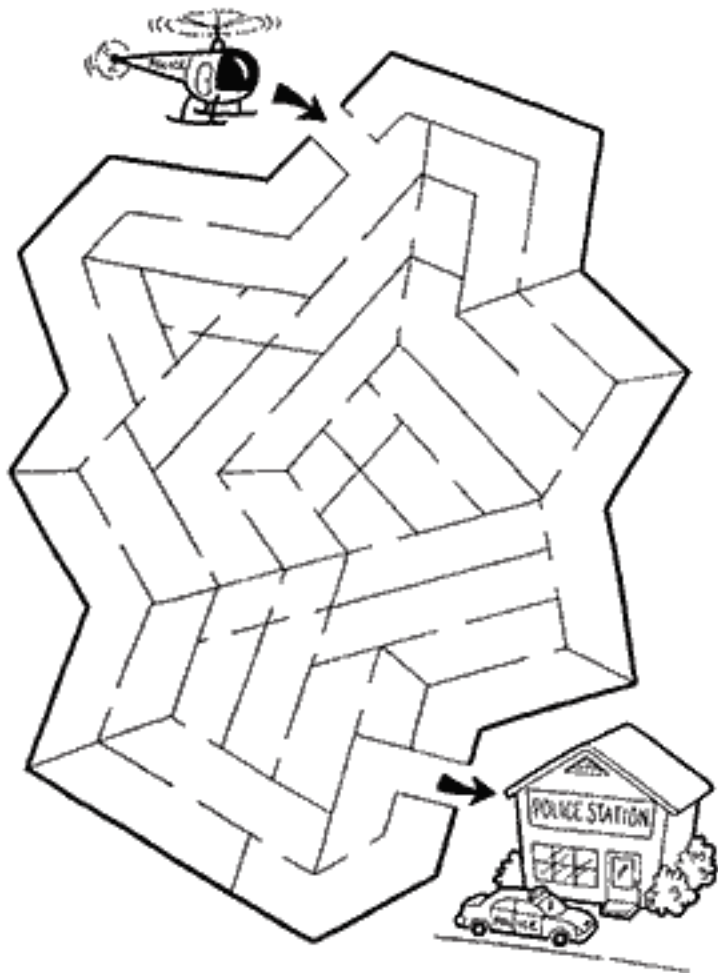
**"That's a lot to remember,"
